You are invited to attend the annual New Jersey State Elks’ Association State-Wide Path to Leadership Conference for 6th, 7th and 8th grade students on bullying, cyber-bullying, social media issues and other related topics.

The Conference will be held on Thursday, February 3, 2022 and is being held at the Ocean Place Resort and Spa in Long Branch, NJ. Check-in begins at 8:30AM. The first program starts at 10AM and Conference concludes at 2:30PM.

One of the presenters for this year’s program is Jared Campbell. Jared is an award winning singer/songwriter who has toured the country speaking at hundreds of schools and playing with national acts such as Jason Mraz, Gavin Degraw and Journey. He uses his music to impact the lives of his listeners to experience joy, find comfort through pain, and look past obstacles. He mixes humor, stories of life on the road and personal experience to help young people with topics such as finding their passion, bullying, acceptance of differences and many other issues that affect young people today.

The cost of the conference is \$50 per attendee which includes a welcome snack upon arrival, all program materials, lunch, conference backpack and more.
