



ENRIQUE CAMARENA AWARD

How It Works:

Nominees for this award start at the local lodge level. The completed applications are then forwarded to the State DAP Chair, where the best nominee is selected and then forwarded to the DAP Directors. The National Winner will be selected in January and the award will be presented at the State Reunion in Wildwood.

Criteria:

- This Award should be presented to an individual and not an organization.
- All nominations must be accompanied by the official Elks Nomination form.
- The nominee should be involved in law enforcement.
- The nominee should be a positive role model and committed to a healthy lifestyle.
- The nominee should have made, or is making, an outstanding contribution in the field drug awareness or prevention.
- The nominee is one who has gone “above and beyond” their normal duties, someone who has made a difference.
- The nominee must have support of their supervisors.
- If selected, must be willing to attend an awards ceremony (in Wildwood on June 6).
- Nominations must be presented in narrative form and include endorsements and recommendations from appropriate sources: Governments, citizens, schools, etc.
- Include information as to how the individual has helped youth and families.
- Nominee should possess leadership & organizational skills.
- Include a list of previous awards & accomplishments.
- The nominees should exemplify “That one person can make a difference.”

What to Submit:

Supporting documentation – write a letter nominating the individual and submit it to your local lodge.
